- Strategies for sustainable architecture: technological aspects to face environmental issues;
- Social aspects, relating to the change in social demand in urban areas;
- Urban governance, to define innovative processes to manage partnership and promote an active citizenship, involving stakeholders and civil society in public decision making;
- Sustainable mobility, transport infrastructure and intermodal transport systems;
- National policies for urban areas, considered in the regional contexts of Italy.
