Theme: Landscape, Urban agriculture and Cultural heritage

Cultural Heritage safeguard and promotion are considered as drivers for achieving many of the Sustainable Development Goals adopted in 2015 by the United Nations, with particular reference for cities and human settlements (SDG 11).

In this view, the Call is focused on cultural heritage revitalization, to raise awareness about the opportunities and challenges of the valorisation process in achieving the interdependent dimensions of urban sustainability: environmental protection, economic development and social growth.

The aim of the Call is to explore:

- actions, case studies for balanced processes of cultural heritage safeguard, in order to share knowledge about good practices to rethink cultural heritage in the general frame of urban development policies;
- evaluative tools and approach for monitoring cultural indicators, considering the importance of a systematic assessment of social, environmental and economic impacts of valorisation processes;
- governance issues and participation of stakeholders in decision making processes;
- cultural landscapes, landscape transformation and development of agricultural areas;
- museum systems and creative networks.
